Cooking a turkey can take up to 5 gallons of cooking grease and by taking that used oil to our event will convert the oil into biodiesel fuel that may be used as a clean burning automotive fuel. Used vegetable oils from turkey frying are very easily turned into biofuels through recycling. Every gallon of waste cooking that is recycled and converted into diesel fuel reduces carbon monoxide, and carbon dioxide. This makes it a cleaner alternative than traditional diesel fuels.

Pouring cooking oils down a drain may eventually cause clogs for your pipes or the municipal sewer lines or cause septic tank and field damage.

We ask the following:

- Bring waste oil to the facility in secure containers.
- Each container will be returned to the resident for them to recycle.
- Only vegetable oils will be accepted.
