

# May 24, 2016

Proceedings, transactions and resolution made and order of said record of said Board in the Village of Diamond, IL on the 24th Day of May 2016.

The scheduled meeting of the Diamond Village Board was held on Tuesday, May 24, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. with Mayor Teresa Kernc presiding. Upon roll call Commissioners present were Jeff Kasher, Dave Warner and Carolyn Wilson. Absent was Addis Dean Johnson.

# Public Hearing - Appropriations Ordinance

**MOTION** was made by Commissioner Wilson, **SECOND** by Commissioner Kasher to open the public hearing to consider the Appropriations Ordinance. **All Ayes; Motion Carried.** 

Commissioner Wilson stated that there are two recommended changes to the budget from Village Accountant Sheryl McDaniel with respect to the Not to Exceed Chamlin Engineering Service Agreements. The painting of the water towers increased from \$5,000 to \$20,000 under the Water Fund to include \$15,000 for one tower and \$20,000 for two towers. Wilson stated that the other recommended change is to increase the Sewer Fund Engineering from \$3,000 to \$17,000 for the lift station generators which includes design and construction engineering and easement survey and platting.

# Approve Mesirow Financial-Employee Benefits Program

Mayor Kernc explained that Village Clerk Lori Holmes had not been contacted back from Coal City regarding their sponsorship for participation in their group medical plan, and it is necessary to consider renewing Diamond's existing plan. She added that Mesirow outlined 3 plans for consideration and the Board also needs to determine whether they want to increase the employee contribution. Following discussion, it was determined that the Village would remain with existing Plan 1 and raise the employee contribution from 5% to 7%. Kernc stated that Clerk Holmes will continue to try to get cooperation from Coal City to determine whether there are better alternatives for the future.

**MOTION** was made by Commissioner Wilson, **SECOND** by Commissioner Warner to approve the Mesirow Financial-Employee Benefits Program, Annual Premium – Plan 1 for \$49,449.48 and a 7% employee contribution. **All Ayes, Motion Carried.**
