## **Engineer Updates**

Village Engineer Mike Perry stated a pre-construction meeting will be held Friday, August 26, 2016 at 1:00 PM for the Stellon Street project. Perry presented a picture of a municipality water tower in which the painting was a deep blue contrasting color. Mayor Kernc stated she would like to do this to our tower as well and by doing so; it will also hide possible future mold build up on the outside of tank. Perry also presented information on an upgraded interior coating to be used on the inside of tank. Commissioner Warner inquired about the 2 different series of paint and Perry stated he would contact the painter to clarify the series of paint along with cost. Perry asked the board for a consensus to execute a change order to the water tower painting project in the amount of \$6,140.00 for the color contrast painting and upgraded interior coating. The Board was in favor of the change. Mayor Kernc stated this would be placed on the next board meeting agenda for formal approval. Perry stated a pre-bid for the generator jobs, which includes all 3 lift stations and well # 4, is scheduled for September 27, 2016 at 10:00 AM. The opening of the bids for this project will be held on October 7, 2016. Perry also stated he is still waiting for the schedule from D Construction regarding the ITEP bike path project.
